2pm	15th and Constitution Avenue NW, east on Constitution Avenue NW to 3rd Street NW, south on 3rd Street NW into Union Square (in front of the Capitol Bldg) where the group will disperse.	March: This is a distance of just over 1 mile. Expect it to take at least 1 hr as part of a large march, plus it will take some time for all marchers to embark. Note: Restrooms — the AAAS Bldg is open all day until after 7pm. There is a post-March happy hour 5:30 – 7pm.
